Forklift Training Tips

It is vital that all workplaces using forklifts have the following checklist or one equivalent on the premises. If all of the safety rules are being followed, each of these questions should be answered with a "yes". A "no" to whichever question indicates a procedural weakness that might lead to injury, damage to equipment or accident.

- 1) Is the operating area of the forklift separate from the traffic of pedestrians?
- 2) Is pedestrian access to forklift travel areas restricted by barriers?
- 3) The pedestrian walkways well-marked?
- 4) A sign is visibly clear stating a "forklift in operation"?
- 5) Are mirrors for drivers and pedestrians provided at blind spots?
- 6) Changes or alterations to the daily forklift schedule has been communicated to employees?
- 7) Are lift truck tires suitable for utilization on all operating surfaces?
- 8) Lift truck seatbelt is being used?
- 9) Is the seat in good condition?
- 10) Is a regular forklift maintenance schedule followed?
- 11) Are yearly inspections of the forklift being carried out?
- 12) Is the kind of forklift appropriate for the tasks?
- 13) Does forklift has a load chart that is readable?
- 14) Could the operators understand and read the load chart?
- 15) The chart lists the safe lifting capacity for all attachments and their uses?
- 16) Do the forklift warning devices work correctly?
- 17) The speed operating control device is secured properly?
- 18) Is overhead cage fitted correctly on the forklift?
- 19) Do the operators of the lift truck have certifications to utilize the machinery?
- 20) Warning signs and speed limits are being observed?
- 21) The operators have current training for the lift trucks being utilized?
- 22) Forklift operators understand their responsibilities to report the damage to the machinery and other forklift accidents?
- 23) Prior to the machine being utilized, the pre-test checklist is being reviewed every day?
