Tasks by equipment operators are normally divided into 3 categories in order to define the kinds of jobs for equipment operators. These 3 categories include heavy equipment operation, truck driving and crane operation. An equipment operator has to become licensed and finish heavy equipment operator classes. This could be common in road work conditions or in an area which gets heavy evening and day traffic. Another example is a work routine of a truck driver can vary depending on whether he is transporting items over hundreds, at times even thousands of miles, while shorter hauls can be completed in a typical work day.
